

## January 12, 2010 Corinth Energy Committee

Present: Ginny Barlow, Chair; Tim O'Dell, Dan Wing, Anne Margolis, Peter Keene and Laurie Sheridan

Meeting began at 7:00 pm. Minutes of December 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting were approved.

Tim alerted the committee that Corinth was on the list of towns whose EECBG Initial Applications were accepted for further consideration. The Comprehensive Application is due by February 23<sup>rd</sup>. Ginny talked with Two Rivers Ottaquechee Commission about helping with the application. They can help by reviewing what the committee prepares before it goes to the State.

The group reviewed the garage project and progress so far. There was discussion about including a new or repaired roof as part of the project, as it is not considered an energy improvement. However, Anne felt the Town could spend its matching funds on the roof, as an intact roof is necessary to keep the new insulation dry and effective.

Discussion followed about heating systems. Garage currently has a hot air system. Proposed plan includes an Energy Star waste oil boiler. Ginny will check with Joe Blodgett about how much waste oil is actually available.

Anne mentioned the importance of the estimate for fuel savings and asked if Energy Wright's estimates are based on measured computations. Tim will check on this.

Using the Initial Application as a guide, the group divided the eight steps to get estimates to have the work done as follows:

Tim will work on items 1, weather sealing; 2, ceiling insulation; 3, exit door; and 4, overhead doors.

Ginny will work on item 5, windows.

Joe Blodgett will be asked to work on item 6, lighting.

Tim and Anne will work on item 7, heating.

Dan and Peter will work on item 8, ventilation.

In addition, Laurie will get the Town's DUNS number and Ginny will contact the Fire Marshall.

The next meeting was set for 7 pm on January 25<sup>th</sup>, with an alternate date of January 26<sup>th</sup>. Peter will check with Joe Blodgett to see which evening works best for him.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm
