

## January 25, 2010 Corinth Energy Committee

Meeting began at 7:00 pm. Minutes of January 12<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved.

Dan and Tim went over their progress in researching waste oil furnaces. Ginny reported that Road Foreman Joe Blodgett thinks there will be adequate waste oil. Location of fuel storage tanks was discussed, and it was agreed there would be room for the tanks. Frank asked if the DEP requires a permit for the waste oil burner. Ginny will look into permit requirements. Payback period for the waste oil burner through savings on fuel costs was roughly estimated at 3 – 5 years. Ginny will check into how much fuel is currently being used.

The group reviewed the Invitation to Bid developed by Tim. The deadline for bidders to get clarifications and answers was changed to February 10, and the due date was changed to February 12, 2010. Tim will email the invitation to builders.

Energy savings measurement was discussed. Mulligan based his work on the current configuration of the bays, but an estimate is needed based on the entire project. Tim will calculate this and get it to Anne.

Dan will continue to work on ventilation options.

The next meeting will be February 15<sup>th</sup>.
