Approved for the following highways (list may be attached): All Town highways, except those with wood-decked bridges which have a 16,000 pound weight limit by State Statute. A damage bond may be required to operate on certain highways during all seasons of the year.

**The following restrictions apply:** Special weight limits will be posted and in effect during Mud Season {typically March 15<sup>th</sup> through May 15<sup>th</sup>} and at other times when ordered by the Selectboard. During these periods, day-to-day permission may be granted by the Road Commissioner or the Road Foreman on a case-by-case basis.

This approval shall be effective for no more than a one year period ending March 31, 20\_\_\_. This approval covers all vehicles bearing the company name. If a permit is to cover unmarked company trucks, please attach a list to this form giving year and make of truck, VIN #, maximum weight and registration #.

The holder of a permit shall be liable for any damage to highways or bridges per VSA Title 23, Sec. 1400a (c) and is required to furnish the municipality a valid Certificate of Insurance in the following amounts: a minimum of \$100,000. / \$300,000. Personal Injury Liability Coverage and \$100,000 Property Damage Coverage.
